





RELEASE 2005

The May Release is always highly anticipated. Usually this is the moment of the year where major changes appear: Re-designed mobile apps, GDPR compliance tools and reporting, new features for IFRS Leasing, new languages & country versions, new KPI and reporting design, and the list continues.

SAP is letting the client speak and picks up suggestions to improve the user experience and general functionality via the “Influence SAP” portal.

The [SAP Business ByDesign Road Map](#) “highlights” a couple of new country specific features, added compliance in areas that need constant attention and improvement in the user experience.

But no promises are made!

Therefore, the SAP Team from Experis Ciber recommends catching the new features via the Help Center item “What’s New”. A simple click on that link will bring Release Highlights and information with reference to specific functional areas to your attention.

TIMING

On the 2nd of May 2020, all SAP Business ByDesign Demo and Test System Tenants will get the release 2005 implemented.

Usually without major disruption of the system’s existing functionality, changes are implemented and readily available.

The changes will then be made available in the Productive Tenant two weeks later: Between 16th and 17th May 2020.




